This is the simple process to participate in the Arts Buddy program:

1. Choose the Arts Buddy performance from the schedule that is enclosed.  
Only performances listed are eligible for Arts Buddy passes.
2. Options for Purchasing a \$5.00 Arts Buddy pass through the CAUSEWAY office.
  - A new pass is needed for each performance and each pass admits two people
  - Payment can be mailed to Causeway, 420 West Avenue S., La Crosse, WI 54601  
*Be sure to include address or a return envelope to mail passes to you!*
  - Office is staffed Mon - Fri from 9:00 a.m. until 12:00 p.m. to purchase passes
3. Call Box Office to make reservations for two tickets. Ask for the specified person or Department if noted on schedule and identify yourself as a Causeway Arts Buddy participant.
4. Present your Arts Buddy pass to the Box Office at the time you pick up your tickets.
